George A. Anzuoni

As we enter the new millennium, and NEPTA's second century of existence, we are inducting the first class into the NEPTA Hall of Fame. One of our inductees, George S. Anzuoni has had a long career in transportation. The Anzuoni family began in Revere Massachusetts with Service Bus Lines and the legacy continues today. As a family in transportation the Anzuoni brothers, George, Larry and Richard, currently operate Plymouth & Brockton Street Railway, Brush Hill Transportation, North Shore Bus Co., and McGinn Bus Co.

Plymouth & Brockton Street Railway was founded 12 years before NEPTA and its predecessor organizations. For the last half century, P&B has been operated by the Anzuoni family. Tonight we honor the President of Plymouth & Brockton Street Railway, George S. Anzuoni.

George has served the transportation industry for the past five decades, not only servicing the traveling public, but mentoring many individuals into industry leadership positions as well. George served as President of this organization in 1980. In 1991, he was NEPTA's "Transportation Man of the Year". He was also the President of the New England Bus Association in 1977 and 1978.

In addition to a distinguished Transportation career, George served his community as well. In 1989, he was the Chairman of the Board of the Plymouth Area chamber of Commerce, and received their award as "The Corporate Citizen of the Year" in 1992.

Regionally, George was appointed to and currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Associated Industries of Massachusetts, and The Alliance for the Commonwealth, an esteemed group whose mission is to guide the development of international trade for Massachusetts. As a member of the Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company of Massachusetts, he participates in the oldest military organization in North America, whose roots still remain in England.

George Anzuoni and his wife Barbara reside in Plymouth and are parents to four grown children. All of the children are involved in the transportation industry. . . . The legacy does continue!
