Among the inductees to this year's NEPTA Hall of Fame is one individual who is very unique. He is the only person to serve as president of two of the NEPTA's predecessor organizations and now honored by the current organization. He served as President of the New England Transit Club in 1969 then, again in 1982 served as president of the New England Passenger Transportation Association and tonight the NorthEast Passenger Transportation Association honors him. J. David White has the distinction of tying together all three names.

Dave began his career with the MBTA in 1959 as the Director of Purchasing and Stores and he continues to be involved today representing equipment suppliers to the transit industry. Through the years, Dave has served on numerous committees both locally and nationally. He chaired the purchasing committee of the American Public Transit Association.

David began his public service at an early age. In Hudson MA, he was the youngest selectman elected in the entire Commonwealth and held that record for many years.
